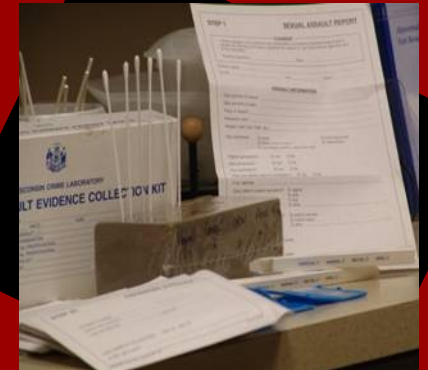

## What is a SANE?

A SANE or Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner is a registered nurse who has been specially trained to care for the complex issues surrounding victims of sexual assault. The purpose of this training is to teach interested Registered Nurses how to better care for their patients by recognizing, collecting and preserving evidence, interviewing victims and linking them to vital community resources for follow-up care.

### Course Description:

This 40-hour didactic course is geared towards the Registered Nurse, but is informative for physicians, law enforcement officers, prosecutors and victim advocates. It is designed to provide comprehensive education program in the complete assessment, evaluation and treatment of the adult sexual assault survivor.

Upon completion of the 40-hour didactic training, there is a post-training of 40-hours of clinical requirement that must be completed according to the nurse's scope of practice and guidelines of the training course. The presenter, Diana Faugno, will set these guidelines out during training.

Prior to training, participants will need to purchase the *Sexual Assault - Forensic & Clinical Management* DVD practicum, available at the [safeta.org](http://safeta.org) website for \$25 (plus shipping and handling).

#### First Day:

- History of forensic nursing roles

- Evidence collection– role of the forensic scientist
- Male sexual assault

#### Second Day:

- Developmental anatomy across the life span
- Medical forensic evaluation of adolescent and adult
- Trauma injury identification
- Strangulation

#### Third Day:

- Elder interview and elder sexual abuse
- Drug facilitated sexual assault
- Documentation and interview of the sexual assault patient
- Treatment, referral and follow-up

#### Fourth Day:

- Testimony and the court room-Role of prosecutor/defense attorney
- Dynamites of sexual assault/rape trauma syndrome
- Role of the advocate
- Procedures of the Police Crime Lab
- Basics of the sexual assault investigation
