




Every kit has a unique number on the front, upper left corner of box. You will reference this throughout the exam. This box is A15-12250




Like food, do not use box if seal has been broken.






Three pieces of paper in each box.

- 1) Kit Instructions
  - a) Use then discard
- 2) Additional Notes for Hospital Personnel
  - a) Review then discard
- 3) WI Crime Lab Information Sheet
  - a) Fill this out in detail, do not leave any fields blank!
  - b) Photocopy and maintain copy for PAVSA SANE Program records. Leave copy in SANE cart.
  - c) Return original with kit.

#### Silver desiccant pouch unfolded (on left)











Evidence seal and biohazard sticker are in the bottom of the box.
