
Advanced Clinical Skills and Case Practice

In these experiences, you will: you will:

- Participate in a workshop on trauma-informed communication/interviewing and on wound documentation/photography, which includes presentations and activities
- Complete a two-phase simulation on 1) trauma-informed interview and 2) head-to-toe assessment with wound documentation and photography, each of which will be followed by group debriefs
- Learn from expert sexual assault nurse examiners
- Gain confidence and competence caring for a patient presenting with a recent experience of sexual violence
- Learn alongside colleagues, taking time to talk through challenges and to practice these skills
