Audience: To become a SANE, you must have a Registered Nursing (RN) license and preferably two years of clinical practice.

Course Description: This 40 hour Adult/Adolescent Didactic SANE-A Course provides SANE the foundational knowledge and critical thinking skills necessary to provide holistic, comprehensive care to adult and adolescent patients that have experienced sexual assault. The Course provides the minimum hours necessary to meet the SANE-A Course eligibility requirements to apply to sit for the Commission for Forensic Nursing Certification examination. There is an additional 16 hour Clinical skills Lab available for the “hands-on” portion of the SANE Training.
